

JOB DESCRIPTION-COUNSELOR

Camp Lutherlyn counselors lead a group of 6-10 campers each week as they participate in the daily camp programming. Counselors act as a friend and role model as they supervise and support campers, ensuring each camper's week is fun, safe and memorable. They stay in a cabin with the campers.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Be accountable to the Camp Directors.
- 2. Work cooperatively with other counselors to ensure all campers are safe, maintaining good health and hygiene, arriving at activities on time, following camp rules, and participating fully in the camp program.
- 3. Know the whereabouts of your campers at all times. If anyone becomes missing, report immediately to the Camp Director or designate.
- 4. Support all campers to the best of your ability, showing compassion, understanding and modeling positive behavior; seek assistance with behavioural, emotional or other difficulties from other counselors,and/or the Camp Directors as needed.
- 5. Actively participate in all camp activities and provide leadership and support for campers.
- 6. Facilitate Cabin activities.
- 7. Work with other staff in planning and leading occasional camp-wide programming (e.g., games).
- 8. Work with the Directors and other Camp Staff to ensure that the goals and objectives of Camp Lutherlyn are carried out.
- 9. Provide one to one support for campers with special needs as determined by the Director or designate.
- 10. Other duties and responsibilities that may be requested by the Camp Directors, within reason.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Minimum 17 years of age (by Dec. 31 of the year of employment).
- 2. Experience in and enjoy working with children.
- 3. Ability to work in a team setting.
- 4. Positive and flexible attitude.
- 5. Standard First Aid and CPR-C certification is an asset.
- 6. Previous camp experience is an asset.
