

He organized Confirmation Camp at Edgewood in the 1990s.

We thank our devoted Treasurer Annette Gilchrist for securing a number of grants! We received the Province of Ontario Covid-19 Business Support Grant (\$10,697), the Ontario Highlands Tourism Organization Tourism Recovery and Innovation Program (\$20,000), and Canada Summer

Jobs grant (\$3179). These funds have allowed us to undertake some projects and contribute to the financial sustainability of the Camp during the pandemic.

Bancroft CABIN

Are you looking for a special place to get away this summer? We have some wonderful spaces, including Bancroft Cabin located at Bancroft Beach. The cabin has a beautiful view of Golden Lake. A section of Bancroft Beach will be reserved for the renters of Bancroft Cabin; it includes a stone fire pit.

The cabin features an open area Living & Dining room with 3 large windows facing the lake, comfortable sofa/ chair seating for 7 and a dining table which seats 6-7. A nook in front of the kitchen is a favourite reading space for many of our guests.

The cabin has 2 bedrooms: one with a double bed, one with a set of bunk beds and a twin bed. And there is a 2nd double bed in another nook in the Living Area. In total, the cabin comfortably sleeps 6 plus a 7th on an upper bunk with a camp mattress.

A kitchen with hot and cold non-potable water, full-sized fridge (no freezer compartment), butane stove, electric frying pan, kettle, and dishes, pots and pans etc. (A jug of potable water will be provided for each stay.)

A bathroom with toilet and sink. Shower facilities are available for Bancroft renters at the new Comfort Station at Main Camp. A BBQ and picnic table are also available.
